Report 2021 CRE Credits Online NOW

Take time to view the CRE credits you have reported and enter any missing credits by **January 31, 2022**.

Note: Your 2021 CDS CRE credits were automatically added to vour records.

Go to the MEMBERS ONLY AREA

- Select Report CRE Credits, fill in the information and select Submit My Credit.
- When complete, select View CRE Credits, change the start and end year to 2021 and select search. Go to the bottom of the page to view the total CRE credits recorded for 2021.

CRE Audit

All members with a designation have the possibility of being selected for the annual audit of the CRE credit hours they reported. Annual audit selections of reported CRE credit for the year are as follows:

- A random selection of 5% of all designees' reporting
- One hundred percent (100%) of all questionable, late, or incomplete reporting

The CRE credit reported by all new members of the Board of Governors is audited in their first year in office. A random selection of 20% of the other Board members' CRE reporting for the year is audited. For details on the audit process, refer to the Policy and Procedures for the Education Committee located in the Members Area.

What does your SOFE Education Committee do?

In addition to recommending changes to the Continuing Regulatory Education (CRE) policies and procedures, the Education Committee assists with the annual CRE audit and reviews and approves non-NASBA listed continuing education providers for inclusion in the online CRE reporting area. The committee also obtains the speakers and sponsors for any SOFE breakfast seminars that may be held at the NAIC seasonal meetings. Each committee member must be a CFE or an AES.

During the past few years, the Education Committee has added offerings for online Ethics CRE on the SOFE website, as well as worked with the NAIC to offer required annual CRE for the Financial Condition Examiners Handbook updates and Financial Analysis Handbook updates.

Over the upcoming year, we are excited to be adding additional online CRE opportunities through SOFE-sponsored webinars via a partnership with vFairs. An announcement on registration will be out soon regardining $4 \frac{1}{2}$ hours of CRE that will be available December 15, 2021 with additional CRE opportunities to be added for the first and/or second quarters of 2022.

We also are working with NAIC staff to provide instructors for the NAIC New Financial Regulator Training and Intermediate/Advanced Financial Regulator Training in 2022.
