Late payments are subject to a \$15 late fee. Failure to submit the required credits by **MARCH 31, 2023** is grounds for SOFE designation suspension.

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Report 2022 CRE Credits Online NOW

Take time to view the CRE credits you have reported and enter any missing credits by JANUARY 31 2023.

▶ Note: Your 2022 CDS CRE credits were automatically added to your records.

HOW TO FILE

- ✓ Go to the MEMBERS ONLY AREA
- ✓ Select Report CRE Credits, fill in the information and select Submit My Credit.
- ✓ When complete, select View CRE Credits, change the start and end year to 2022 and select search. Go to the bottom of the page to view the total CRE credits recorded for 2022.

CRE Audit

All members with a designation have the possibility of being selected for the annual audit of the CRE credit hours they reported. Annual audit selections of reported CRE Credit for the year are as follows:

- ✓ A random selection of 5% of all designees' reporting
- ✓ One hundred percent (100%) of all questionable, late or incomplete reporting.

The CRE credit reported by all new members of the Board of Governors is audited in their first year in office. A random selection of 20% of the other Board members' CRE reporting for the year is audited. For details on the audit process, refer to the Policy and Procedures for the Education Committee located in the Members aArea.

Submissions for the 2023 CDS Meeting must be completed by JANUARY 19, 2023.

- > The information provided through this form will be used by the CDS Committee to objectively select those speakers that will comprise the CDS Agenda.
- > A separate form must be completed for each presentation being proposed.
- > Submissions for panel discussions involving more than one speaker should be submitted by a single presenter.
- Please list all speakers or presenters who will participate, including all appropriate designations i.e. CFE, AFE, AES, CISA, CPA, etc. Incomplete applications will not be accepted. Late applications may be accepted on an as-needed basis.
- > Biographies and photos of presenters are required at the time of submission.
- ➤ If submitting a presentation in accounting, auditing, or taxes, to remain in compliance with the NASBA Statement on Standards for CPE Programs, Standard No. 5, please include the participation of at least one licensed CPA (in good standing).

When submitting please allow a few seconds for the form to load. Complete the form online and then hit the "Submit" button on the form, allowing 60 seconds before closing your browser. A confirmation e-mail will be sent upon successful completion of the online form.



Future Sites Committee Corner

The SOFE Future Sites Committee is responsible for the identification, review, and selection of hotel venues for the annual Career Development Seminar (CDS) held each year in July. This Committee is not a standing formal committee of the Board but is re-appointed on an annual basis.

Each year, the CDS is moved to different geographic areas of the country to help to maximize attendance potential for the various Insurance Departments and members. We try to select venues on the east coast, southeast, mid-west, west coast, etc. every couple of years to maximize the potential. For example, our current schedule consists of:

| 2023 | Louisville, KY | Central/East |
|------|-------------------|--------------|
| 2024 | Oklahoma City, OK | Central |
| 2025 | San Diego, CA | West Coast |
| 2026 | Orlando, FL | East Coast |

Currently, the Committee is looking to book properties five years out. This allows SOFE to maximize options for available space and also to maximize benefits for early booking. SOFE currently has a separate Meeting Service contract with Cindy Dodson of Meeting Services Inc. (MSI) to provide support and services for the meeting process.

Site Selection Criteria/Preferences:

- Amount of meeting space needed (CDS Minimum Requirements). It is necessary to host and feed the entire group in one venue. Consideration is given to the current CDS Schedule.
- Number of hotel rooms needed on the property (CDS Minimum Requirements)
- Available Overflow Hotel Options
- Hotel room Rate
- Food and Beverage Costs
- Proximity to the airport or other transportation considerations
- Convenience of surrounding areas for evening activities
- Sunday Social Options
- Value of Hotel Concessions


